Follow the Step-by-Step Instructions below to confidently reset their Candidate Home password.

Step	Action
1	Select the Forgot Password button.
2	Enter the original email address used to create the account.
3	A generated email will be sent to the email the candidate entered.
4	After selecting the link in the email, it will route the candidate back to the external career site to reset their password.
5	Once the password is reset, it will instruct them to login with the new password.
6	Select Submit.

Best Practice

Before initiating a reset, ask the candidate to check their spam or junk folder for the password reset email. Sometimes, it's already waiting!

Keep in Mind

Only candidates can reset their passwords, but you can resend the password by reset email or walk them through the process. Offering timely guidance helps reduce frustration and shows that you're there to help.
